OceanWorks Delivers PRMS Submarine Rescue Vehicle to U.S. Navy

North Vancouver, British Columbia - OceanWorks International has delivered the U.S. Navy's next-generation submarine rescue system, the "Pressurized Rescue Module System" (PRMS) to its home base at the Navy's Deep Submergence Unit in San Diego, CA.

The PRMS replaces the existing U.S. submarine rescue asset, the DSRV Mystic. The delivery is the culmination of several years of development by OceanWorks as the U.S. Navy's prime contractor and system integrator for the U.S. Navy's SRS-RCS program.

Having completed several weeks of sea trials and successful demonstration of all system performance requirements, the PRMS will now undergo operational and technical evaluation by the Navy before entering service. Built to the U.S. Navy's certification standard

for manned deep submergence systems (NAVSEA P9290), the PRMS is designed, built and tested to exacting standards and represents a quantum step forward in submarine rescue technology.
